Each year the primary schools are grouped into 6 clusters Ryde, The Bay, Ventnor, Cowes, Newport and West Wight & Carisbrooke. These clusters are given an international island to represent across 7 different sports.

This year the 7 sports will be Athletics, Kwik Cricket, Swimming, Basketball, Netball, Quicksticks Hockey and for the first time Handball.

Each cluster will chose 72 children across the 7 sports, each sport will hold its own tournament where a winner will be decided. Points are awarded to each team depending on where they placed within each sport, each clusters points are added up and an overall winner is named. At the last games in 2010 the winning cluster representing St Helena was Ryde.
