9. **Minutes**

RESOLVED:

THAT the Minutes of the meeting held on [6 August 2012](#) be confirmed.

10. **Declarations of Interest**

There were no declarations received at this stage.

11. **Exclusion of Public and Press**

RESOLVED:

THAT, under Section 100(A)(4) of the Local Government Act 1972, the public and press be excluded from the meeting for the following item of business, namely Minute number 12, on the grounds that there was likely to be disclosure of exempt information as defined in paragraphs 1 and 2 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Act and in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.

12. **Confidential Report of the Director of Schools and Learning**

The chairman welcomed those present and introduced members of the committee. He confirmed that all members had read the papers and outlined the procedure that was to be followed.

Consideration was given to appeals relating to school transport.

(a) Hearing 114 (12/13) (Paper B)

The Sub Committee received representations from the Children's Services representative, members of the Sub Committee asked questions.

The appellant then outlined her case covering several points covered in the initial documentation submitted and highlighted that since appealing, her daughter had decided she wished to return to her priority school. Members of the Sub Committee asked questions.

The Children Services representative and the appellant then withdrew, whilst the Sub Committee adjourned to consider the appeal.

The Sub Committee having considered all the reasons given by the appellant in her written and oral submissions, agreed to refuse the appeal.

RESOLVED:

THAT the appeal be refused.

(b) Hearing 113 (12/13) (Paper C)

The Sub Committee received representations from the Children's Services representative; members had no further questions at this stage.

The appellants then outlined their case expanding on several points contained in the documentation previously submitted. Members of the Sub Committee asked questions of the appellant.

The Children Services representative responded to points raised by the appellants and drew attention to elements of the documentation previously circulated.

The Children's Services representative and the appellants then withdrew, whilst the Sub Committee adjourned to consider the appeal.

The Sub Committee having considered all the reason given by the appellants both written and oral submission, decided that the appeal be refused.
