Application: An application for the grant of a Street Trading Consent

submitted by Mr Lee Wheldon

Resolution: Upon receiving the report of the licensing section, oral

and written evidence from the applicant and objectors, and having regard to the Isle of Wight Council's Interim Statement of Licensing Policy (Street Trading Consents) adopted in July 2008, the sub committee hereby grant the Street Trading Consent in accordance with the application as amended during the hearing. Save the consent shall only last for a period of three

months from the issue of the consent.

Conditions: As per application.

Reasons for Decision:

In reaching the decision the Sub Committee had regard to the Human Rights Act 1998, and in particular Article
