61. Change of Executive Governance

Members were advised that the Council's Executive Governance arrangements would require amendment following the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007. Council was asked to consider adopting a "strong leader model", in which a Leader would be elected for a four-year period, with provision for Council to remove the leader mid-term..

RESOLVED:

- 1. THAT Option 1 be approved in that the Leader and Cabinet Executive model of governance be adopted as from June 2009.
- 2. THAT the following paragraphs of Article 7 of the Constitution be amended:
 - (a) Paragraph 3 to state that the Leader will be a Councillor elected at the first annual meeting immediately following an election and that he will hold office until the day of the annual Council meeting following the next election.
 - (b) Paragraph 3(d) by adding: "Such a resolution to be a motion of "No Confidence in the Leader" submitted in accordance with Procedure Rule 10 of the Procedure Rules for the Regulation of Procedures – Full Council.

(c) An additional paragraph 3(e) be added stating: "That where, in accordance with paragraph 3(d) above, a Leader has been removed by resolution, a new Leader shall be elected either at the meeting at which the Leader is removed from office, or at a subsequent meeting".
