- 4. I have received notice that Mrs Lawson has resigned from the Island First Group. I attach at appendix A the necessary calculation for the different size of Committees.
- 5. The legislation also requires that the total of all the seats on the Committees of the Council must also be in proportion to the proportions on the Council as a whole. The effect of the changes are as follows:

Island First:	One less on seat on each of the following:

Conservatives:	No Change
Labour:	No Change
Mrs Lawson:	To have two seats as decided by Council
