Superfast broadband consultation

The Isle of Wight Council has secured funding from government, to help pay for the installation of superfast broadband across the Island. Superfast broadband provides high speed access to online services such as the internet. It will provide you with a reliable and uninterrupted internet connection at significantly higher speeds (up to 100 Mega bits per second – Mb/s).

The Island can have world class, leading edge communications and internet services. Businesses will benefit from increased download/upload speeds and fewer problems connecting to the internet. Remote working, away from your business premises, will also be vastly improved via superfast connections, allowing you to connect to your office computers in real time without interruption. The council believes superfast broadband will help businesses on the Island to work more efficiently as well develop their 'online'

services. In addition it could help attract new businesses to the Island, which would contribute to more employment opportunities and stimulate the Island's economy.

Without superfast broadband it will become increasingly difficult for Island businesses to compete in a growing internet based economy or to develop advanced services and products for the internet.
