Isle of Wight Drug and Alcohol Misuse





National Treatment Agency (NTA)

- Double the number of people in effective, well-managed treatment from 100,000 in 1998 to 200,000 in 2008
- Increase the proportion of people who successfully complete or, if appropriate, continue treatment.

Drug Misuse on the IOW

- Estimated 432 and 621 Problem Drug Users (PDUs) aged between 15 – 64
- Estimated 203 and 367 Injecting Drug Users (IDUs) aged between 15 – 64
- At 31st March 2008:
 - 546 people in treatment aged 13yrs and above
 - 87% retention < 12 weeks in treatment
- Excellent NTA overall performance rating for delivering the IOW Adult Treatment Plan (ATP)
- Achieving GOSE targets for Drug Intervention Programme (DIP)
