The deposit for each registered political party or individual candidate (£5,000) may be paid by cash or bankers draft (banks operating in the UK or Gibraltar only) and, with my prior permission, electronic payment into my account (no additional fee) or by credit or debit card (with an additional transaction fee).

To cancel or alter postal and proxy votes, or to change from postal to proxy voting	5pm on 19 May 2009

Proxy on the grounds of physical incapacity if the applicant becomes incapacitated after 5pm on 27 May 2009	5pm on 4 June 2009
