

NOTICE OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places within the Constituency of the Isle of Wight.

1. The Isle of Wight Council is conducting a review of the Polling Districts and Polling Places within the Constituency of the Isle of Wight.
2. The Acting Returning Officer for the Constituency of the Isle of Wight will make representations to the Isle of Wight Council on the Polling Districts and Polling Places, and these will be published by the Isle of Wight Council.
3. Electors within the Constituency of the Isle of Wight may make representations to the Isle of Wight Council on the Polling Districts and Polling Places.
4. The Isle of Wight Council welcomes representations from any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability on any proposals the authority may make, on the Acting Returning Officer's representation or on any other related matter.
5. Wherever possible, persons or bodies making representations should give details of alternative premises that may be used as Polling Stations.

7. All representations should be made by 1st October 2010, and any amendments to the Polling Districts and Polling Places within the Constituency of the Isle of Wight will take effect from 1st December 2011.
