



COMMENTARY

The data and chart, **top**, show that between 1998 - 2007 there were on average 1169 live births to IW residents each year. The highest annual figure in this period was 1,282 births in 2006.

The data and chart, **bottom**, show projected live births for the next 10 years (2008 - 2017), based on the 1998 - 2007 actual data. If this projection materialises, there would be over 1300 live births a year by 2017, with an annual average of 1,265 over the next 10 year period.




