M07/09/12 ISLE OF WIGHT COUNCILLOR'S REPORT

Councillor Stewart reported that Chale Parish Council would soon be receiving 420 trees from the Woodland Trust and would like to offer some to Niton and Whitwell Parish Council.

RESOLVED: that the Clerk asks the Clerk to Chale Parish Council what types of trees are available.

Councillor Stewart had met with the developer hoping to build on Niton Football ground land. He outlined the proposed benefits to the community.

The Isle of Wight Council will soon be consulting on its budget for next year. There will be a cut in Government funding for Council tax benefit and the Isle of Wight council is looking to protect vulnerable persons and pensioners from its effects.

Councillor Stewart reported that he had been appointed to the Cabinet with responsibility for Public Health, Community Safety, Local Services and Heritage. Members of the parish Council offered their congratulations to him on his appointment.

M08/09/12 ISLE OF WIGHT ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL COUNCILS (IWALC) MEETING

Councillor Young gave a report on the meeting held on Thursday 20th September. Clarification of the new regulations for disclosure of Councillors' interests had been received; councillors' spouses'/partners' interests should be declared but do not have to be declared separately.

M09/09/12 BUS STOPPING ARRANGEMENTS IN WHITWELL

RESOLVED: that the Clerk writes to Southern Vectis to say that the Parish Council wants the bus to stop outside the 'White Horse Inn' public house adjacent to the seat, and the Whitwell Church stop relocated to the end of Ashknowle Lane.

M10/09/12 SPEEDING RESTRICTION IN VENTNOR ROAD, WHITWELL

The Clerk had written to Mr Ian Middleton of the Isle of Wight Council Highways and Transport department asking for the speeding restriction in Ventnor Road to be extended to Dean Farm. Mr Middleton had rejected the Parish Council's proposal stating that the section of road has been assessed in accordance

with its adopted speed limit policy and referring to data collected in 2010 which indicates that the average speed of vehicles past Dean Farm is 33 mph with 85% of vehicles travelling at or below 38 mph.

RESOLVED: that the Clerk asks Mr Middleton for a copy of this data and the exact location from which it was obtained.

RESOLVED: that the Clerk asks the Police for any data that they may be holding on collisions outside Dean Farm.

M11/09/12 SALVATION ARMY CLOTHING BANK

The Clerk had received an e-mail from Mr Julian Sharpe of the Salvation Army Trading Company enquiring about the siting of a clothing bank within the Parish.

- 1. P/01287/12 AGN/31212 Agricultural Prior Notification for a storage barn on Part OS Parcel 4071 adjacent Redhill Farm, Southford Lane, Whitwell: **NO OBJECTIONS**; recommend approval.
- 2. P/01293/12 TCP/31120/A Householder Application Demolition of garden structure; proposed single storey building to provide studio; alterations to vehicular access to include removal of entrance gate; formation of parking area (revised scheme) at 5, Radio Station House, Castlehaven Lane, Niton Undercliff: NO OBJECTIONS; recommend approval.
- 3. P/01333/12 TCP/31220 Householder Application Demolition of conservatory; single storey side extension to provide additional living accommodation at 19, Priory Walk, Niton: **NO OBJECTIONS; recommend approval**.
- 4. P/01350/12 TCP/24069/B Householder Application Demolition of existing annex; proposed single storey side extension to form swimming pool and associated facilities with glazed link at Cleveland House, Sandrock Road, Niton Undercliff: Niton and Whitwell Parish Council, having read the paperwork, resolved by 4 votes to 3 to make the following comments: **OBJECTION**; **recommend refusal** on the following grounds:
 - The proposed extension is higher than the original building;
 - The proposal is out of character with the AONB in which it sits;
 - Cumulative effect of multiple extensions to the original building:
 - Increased visibility from the road;
 - Overall footprint is larger than the original building.
