FROM THE FLOOR	PC Downer spoke on recent crime statistics in Wroxall and current trends. Overall crime reports had increased from 14 to 18 (2009 to 2010) but reports of anti-social behaviour were up from 53 to 73. Four acceptable behaviour contracts had been offered and two accepted. Those refusing would have this taken into account if stopped on subsequent occasions. The Wroxall Spar shop was included in the Ventnor Shop Watch scheme which could institute six month bans. Speedwatch had taken place on 7 October; just one vehicle in 100 had been found over the limit. Mr Clarkson was still trying to attract schoolchildren to help on the allotment project. The police were supporting the MUGA bid for lottery funding. Mr McGovern spoke about his imminent revised planning application for English Heritage approved gates 4 m inside his property.
