RESOLVED To confirm the minutes of the meeting held on 9 November as a true and accurate record. The Chairman signed the minutes.

73/09-10 MATTERS ARISING NOT REQUIRING A RESOLUTION

(i) <u>Toilets winter closure</u>

The Clerk had received a response from IoWC.

- (ii) Bollards to protect daffodil planting, St Johns Rd
 Cllr Downer reported the IoW Council had agreed to put in seven
 wooden posts to protect the area from vehicles, leaving the Parish
 Council to sow grass and replant with bulbs.
- (iii) <u>Village Welcome Signs</u>

The Clerk now had a quotation of £435 per sign from A J Wells of Newport.

(iv) Vehicle+trailer in lay-by near Donkey Sanctuary

The Chairman's leads had failed to come up with any further clues to ownership of the land. It was suggested the PC approach IoWC to explore options for it becoming Parish land.

(v) <u>Bridgfields Estate, Planning Enforcement</u>

The Parish Council's complaint had been acknowledged and an officer had visited the site to explain to the owners that they needed to submit a planning application to regularise their activities.

74/09-10 TO DISCUSS THE POSITION OF THE WROXALL COMMUNITY ASSOPCIATON

The Chair reported meeting the Trustees and Committee of the Association, when a serious financial situation was revealed. There was some confusion due to the Treasurer resigning abruptly and consequent difficulty of getting the Bank to deal with those now trying to the run the Association. It was agreed that the Chairman of the Association would supply the Chairman of the Parish Council with up--to-date figures, and a forecast, in advance of the Parish Council meeting on 11 January, when the matter of any grant aid could be discussed.

75/09-10 TO APPROVE PROVISION OF EXTRA STREET LIGHT IN YARBOROUGH RD

The Clerk had followed up the issue of the pedestrian accident and Street Lighting had agreed to the provision of an extra light, by the electricity sub station if the Parish Council requested this. It was **RESOLVED** to request the extra street light in Yarborough Rd be provided.

The Clerk read the list of correspondence received. It was agreed to consider the quotations for a new notice board at the next meeting.

80/09-10 ANY OTHER URGENT BUSINESS (Not requiring a resolution)

- (a) Cllr. Cole said he had received adverse comments about the 'scrap yard' on Ventnor Rd. Unfortunately Planning was not being breached.
- (b) Cllr Underwood said the allotments were nearly filled and asked about water supply at the allotments and the Chairman explained the consequences of providing a supply. The Grove Rd allotments were owned by IoWC, but might be passed to the Parish Council in future.
- (c) Cllr Clayton request that the Parish Council write to BT seeking improvement of the internet connection speed in the village..
- (d) Cllr Gallop said the southbound bus stop in St John's Rd near Appuldurcombe Lane was overgrown and waiting passengers could not see the approaching bus. Cllr Underwood said this was a long-standing problem; a mirror was suggested if cutting back growth did not work. The Dog Bin at the junction of Appuldurcombe Lane/Redhill Lane was Not being emptied. The Christmas+New Year rubbish collection Arrangements were tabled. The IWALC affiliation fee for 2010/11 would be £227.
