RESOLVED to recommend that the application be refused. Material

considerations are:

the proposal is unacceptable in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and will impact on the skyline in a prominent way, destroying the rural character; if granted the application would set a precedent for other wind turbines in the AONB:

constant background noise will permanently destroy the peace and quiet of the surrounding AONB and impact on local residents (made worse by the two-blade design) that could lead to the development of vibro-acoustic disease;

the strobe effect and sun flicker could cause anxiety and adverse health effects;

the strobe effect and sun flicker could cause anxiety and adverse health effects; the site is with 50 m of the Stenbury trail GL51/V37 creating serious safety issues for equestrians;

there are independent accounts of bats in the area that could be killed by the spinning blades, and there is a danger of bird strikes;

Rew Down is a local nature reserve and Site of Special Scientific Interest and will be detrimentally affected by its proximity to the site;

any economic benefits are outweighed by the environmental considerations.
