- (a) Cllr Cole said the white lines painted outside Gresham House were totally ineffective. It was agreed that kerbing was the only solution. Cllr Downer agreed to pursue with Highways through a site meeting.
- (b) Cllr Langdon said the Council's web address should appear in The Way. She referred to the effect on neighbours of the placing of solar panels on the roofs of SW Housing properties in St Martin's Rd.
- (c) Cllr Rickards referred to problems in IWC management of the Grove Rd allotments.
- (d) Cllr Clayton said summer growth by Stenbury View needed trimming. He referred to a growth in low-level anti-social behaviour (Chairman to speak to police).
- (e) Cllr Gallop said the dog waste bin at Appuldurcombe Rd/Redhill Lane was overflowing because customers of the holiday camp were using it. The Clerk advised that a larger size bin was on order. He was asked to write to the manager of the camp.
- (f) Cllr Downer said the the 'new' bus stop at the Four Seasons had been completed.
