<u>32/09-10</u>	<ul> <li>ANY OTHER URGENT BUSINESS (Not requiring a resolution)</li> <li>(a) Cllr. Court reported Spar Shop's alarm going off during the early hours. He referred to plastic bin bags being broken open by animals early on Thursday mornings; Chairman will discuss procedures with Island Waste.</li> <li>The Dog Waste Bin at Stenbury View was in bad condition and needed replacing. Mr Dea would address this and the one at West St. Although the poles for the 20 mph limit outside the school had been erected some weeks ago, there was no sign of the order taking effect.</li> <li>(b) Cllr Cole reported the continuing use of Horse+Traps on the old railway line. The Clerk was already in correspondence with IoW Council on this.</li> <li>(c) Cllr Rickards said the public toilets should be made accessible for people with disabilities.</li> <li>(d) Cllr Clayton said patching in Mountfield Rd was to a very poor standard. He drew attention to the latest craze of stunt bikes. Mr Dea would try to get the Ventnor PCSO to attend a village surgery.</li> <li>(e) Cllr Gallop said the Bridgefields Estate planning application had been refused.</li> <li>He referred to the need for a litter bin at the bus stop outside the Four Seasons. A skip would be needed at the Allotments to remove the material cut down by the Probation Service gang. Clerk to arrange. The issue of parking off St Martin's Rd had been taken up with South Wight Housing.</li> </ul>
