ANY OTHER URGENT BUSINESS (Not requiring a resolution)

(d) Cllr Clayton said summer growth on the south side of Upper Mountfield Rd was hindering access. Clerk to write to Mr Corry of Span Farm.

(e) Cllr Gallop said the dog waste bin at Appuldurcombe Rd/Redhill Lane had been replaced by a larger size. The Clerk had written to the owner of the caravan park, but received no reply.

(f) Harry Dea said he had visited the allotments with the Police, and wondered if some high netting would resolve the problem with footballs. A site in Cowes had recently been treated at a cost of £1800.

The MUGA was on the reserve list for Lottery funding. He had attended the beat surgery, but no particular issues had been raised.

He explained that this was the last Parish meeting he would attend as ENO as the scheme was being abandoned due to IoWC financial cuts. 22 posts were being trimmed to 12 from 1 September (4 Community support, 8 Waste Management) and he would be a CSO. The Council expressed its disappointment at the abrupt disappearance of ENOs and the Parish liaison role, without consultation. Mr Dea was thanked for his valuable efforts in the Parish and wished good luck in his new role.
