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Records must be retained for 12 months and produced on demand to an Inspector

Persons owning or keeping a flock of poultry comprising of at least 250 birds must keep a record showing those entering or leaving the premises.

Persons engaged in the transport or marketing of any poultry or eggs (including slaughterers or auctioneers) must keep a record showing those transported or marketed.

Poultry is defined as being domestic fowls, turkeys, geese, ducks, guinea fowls, quails, pigeons, ratites (ostriches, emus), and pheasants and partridges reared or kept in captivity for breeding, the production of meat or eggs for consumption or for restocking supplies of game.
