<b>Decision reference</b>	45/09
<b>Decision taken</b>	THAT the areas be designated, the appraisal documents be adopted and an Article 4(2) Direction be made in relation to the land, removing the permitted development rights, as detailed in the background papers of the report.
<b>Reasons for decision</b>	To support the Eco Island Priorities and the Council's Corporate Priorities of enhancing how our local areas look and feel, protecting and enhancing the Islands natural beauty and helping to support economic development and regeneration.
<b>Additional reasons</b>	To help enhance the Island's built environment and heritage as well as address the issue of local distinctiveness which has been very clearly articulated within the work of local communities on Town and Parish Plans and Village Design Statements.
