Decision taken	<p>That:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. the Isle of Wight Council (Various Streets, Wroxall, Isle of Wight) Order No 1 2006 be approved. 2. the proposed restrictions to introduce No Waiting At Any Time in Worsley Drive, on the north side, from a point 13.7 metres west to a point 24 metres west of its junction with St John's Road, be implemented as advertised. 3. the proposed restrictions to introduce No Waiting At Any Time in St John's Road, on the west side, from a point 30.5 metres north to a point 47.5 metres north of its junction with Worsley Drive, be implemented as advertised.
Reason	The recommended Orders will contribute to the delivery of targets under Theme 1 of the Community Strategy (Guaranteeing the quality of life and sustainability) and particularly targets 1.24, to reduce the number of people killed or seriously injured in road accidents by 40% by the year 2010 and 1.41, to cut the number of short car journeys.
