<b>Item</b>	<a href="#"><u>Objections to the Isle of Wight Council (Various Streets, Brading, IW) (One Way Traffic) Order No 1 2006</u></a>
<b>Decision reference</b>	17/07
<b>Decision taken</b>	To approve the Isle of Wight Council (Various Streets, Brading, IW) (One Way Traffic) Order No 1 2006, in light of objections received, to introduce a one way traffic flow restriction in the following length of road;  Morton Manor Road, Brading, in a north to south direction, from its junction with Morton Old Road, Brading, to a point 10 metres north thereof.
<b>Reasons for decision</b>	To contribute to the delivery of targets under Theme 1 of the Community Strategy (Guaranteeing the quality of life and sustainability) and particularly targets 1.24, to reduce the number of people killed or seriously injured in road accidents by 40% by the year 2010 and 1.41, to cut the number of short car journeys.
