Item	<u>Objections to the Isle of Wight Council (Various Streets, Niton and Whitwell) (Traffic Regulation) Order No 2 2007</u>
Decision reference	10/08
Decision taken	That Option (ii) is adopted: a. Institute Hill – Implement proposed restriction as recommended. b. High Street & Blackgang Road – Implement proposed restriction as recommended.
Reasons for decision	The recommended Orders will contribute to the delivery of targets under Theme 1 of the Community Strategy (Guaranteeing the quality of life and sustainability) and particularly targets 1.24, to reduce the number of people killed or seriously injured in road accidents by 40% by the year 2010 and 1.41, to cut the number of short car journeys.
Additional reasons	The recommended Traffic Regulation Orders are, in part, designed to increase road safety by reducing both the incidents of traffic crime and consequences to other road users of traffic crime. The recommendations are made with regard to the duty to reduce incidents of crime and disorder contained within s17 Crime and disorder Act 1998.
