<b>Decision reference</b>	02/11
<b>Decision taken</b>	Option 1 – THAT a nucleus crewing system be implemented
<b>Reasons for decision</b>	To enable the Isle of Wight Fire and Rescue Service (IWFRS) to carry out more preventative and protection work helping to reduce the number of fires, particularly in high risk areas.
<b>Additional reasons</b>	To improve availability and ensure day cover during the working week as well as marginally improving cover at night.  To keep both Shanklin and Sandown fire stations open in the interim.
<b>Options considered and rejected</b>	Option 2 – To implement the decision of 13 July 2010 by creating a day crewed station at Sandown
