<b>Decision taken</b>	Option a) - THAT the right of way on the terms detailed in the report be granted.
<b>Reasons for decision</b>	To form part of the ‘Delivering of Budget Savings Through Change Service Provision’, a key corporate priority within the council’s Corporate Plan.  To contribute towards the council’s key corporate priority, of Raising Educational Standards, also outlined in the Corporate Plan
<b>Additional reasons</b>	To reinvest the capital receipt received into the schools reorganisation programme.  To contribute towards the council’s key corporate priorities of “Housing and Homelessness”, through the developer’s provision of housing, and “Regeneration and the Economy”, with the improvement of the school drive.
