<b>Decision taken</b>	Option 1 - THAT the council to consults on the proposals contained in the document ( <a href="#">Appendix 1</a> ) and then considers the responses received from the public and other concerned agencies  That the council agrees to the results of consultation being brought forward for consideration after the 11th June 2012 closure date.
<b>Reason for decision</b>	To support the Corporate Plan in that there are implications for raising educational standards for the Islands young people directly involved and also for mainstream schools in terms of keeping children safe by helping to manage difficult behaviour, attendance and exclusion issues.
