Item	<u>Wightcare – Developing a Re-ablement Service for Older People</u>
Decision reference	39/07
Decision taken	To endorse the Wightcare - Developing a Re-ablement Service for Older People business case and establish a short term re-ablement service on the Isle of Wight.
Reasons for decision	To provide an opportunity for a redesigned home care service that moves away from traditional approaches, to one that is more targeted, delivering national and local priorities.
Additional reasons	To avoid creating more dependency based solutions and restricted options for individual older people that prevents them to remain at home in their communities.
Options considered and rejected	To offer continuity of present service delivery, thus not preparing the service to meet future demographic demands and deliver a model that has sustainable future generating resources.
