41/04 APPROVAL OF THE IEG4 SUBMISSION TO THE ODPM

The Portfolio Holder gave consideration to the approval of the IEG4 submission to the ODPM. This was required for all Councils and informed the distribution of a further £150,000 of local government capital funding from the ODPM in 2005/06. It was noted that Fire and Rescue Services were required to submit their own IEG statements.

Since 2001 when the Government began the initiative of Implementing Electronic Government Councils had been required to make an annual return against a set of IEG criteria. The goals set by central Government had evolved over the last four years with experience from national projects and emerging technologies. The implementation of the various components would be driven by local priorities, and each service had set out in its service plans how electronic government would best deliver improved services.
