[PUBLIC CONVENIENCE CLEANSING AND MINOR MAINTENANCE
CONTRACT](#)

The Portfolio Holder gave consideration to the award of the Public Cleansing and Minor Maintenance Contract for the period November 2004 to March 2008. Procedures had been followed in accordance with the Council's Contract Standing Orders and Procurement Strategy and in particular the European Procurement legislation. The report set out details of the tenders that had been received together with the financial implications of the tender specifications. The report identified a number of viable options and evaluated each. The option to award the contract to Contractor A for all 71 public conveniences for the medium level service would provide a level of service that was not significantly less than the present service and would continue to allow some flexibility in its provision. Any potential future closures or transfers of public conveniences would either allow the level of service to increase to the present existing level or would provide budget savings.

DECISION TAKEN :

THAT the contract be awarded to Contractor A for all 71 public conveniences for the medium level service costing £259,010 subject to additional funding being made available corporately, or reducing the contingency allowance by £1,810
