29/03 EXTENSION TO ISLANDER CARD CONCESSIONARY FARES SCHEME

Consideration was given to an extension to the Islander Card concessionary fares scheme that would enable people with disabilities to purchase rover tickets at half fare. The scheme currently enabled the purchase of half fare single tickets on Isle of Wight registered local bus services and half fare cheap day return tickets on the Island Line rail service to those aged 60 or more, qualified within one of seven criteria of disability, or who were aged 14 or 15.

The extension of rover ticket availability within the scheme would be a desirable next step and would offer the opportunity for greater social inclusion for beneficiaries as well as addressing any potential threat of litigation in respect of discrimination against people with disability. The financial and budget implications of extending the scheme were set out in the report.
