

## WITHDRAWAL OF CABINET MEMBER DELEGATED DECISION

<b>Item</b>	<a href="#">School Organisation – Decision On The Viability of a Federation Proposal for Chale CE VC Primary School</a>

<b>Statement on Withdrawal of Intended Notice of Decision</b>	<p>Following the Cabinet decision of 1 October 2009 to discontinue Chale CE Primary School, the council received a proposal from the governing body of Chale CE Primary School for a federation with the proposed new Rural Primary School (the new school to be created by the amalgamation of Chillerton &amp; Rookley, Godshill and Wroxall Primary Schools).</p> <p>The viability of this proposal and possible subsequent revocation proposal for the discontinuance were due to be determined by delegated decision and accordingly a report was published on 14 December 2009.</p> <p>However, before this Delegated Decision could be made, a further <a href="#">Cabinet decision on 9 February 2010 withdrew the proposal to create the new Rural Primary School</a>. This withdrawal meant that the federation partner proposed by Chale CE Primary School would no longer exist and therefore the Chale CE Primary School proposal became null and void.</p> <p>Chale CE Primary School was given the opportunity to seek a federation with the existing and now continuing schools of Chillerton &amp; Rookley, Godshill and Wroxall primaries but no federation proposal was forthcoming.</p> <p>The delegated decision report on the null and void federation proposal has therefore now been withdrawn.</p>
