Statement on Withdrawal of Intended Notice of Decision	Following the Cabinet decision of 1 October 2009 to discontinue Chale CE Primary School, the council received a proposal from the governing body of Chale CE Primary School for a federation with the proposed new Rural Primary School (the new school to be created by the amalgamation of Chillerton & Rookley, Godshill and Wroxall Primary Schools).
	The viability of this proposal and possible subsequent revocation proposal for the discontinuance were due to be determined by delegated decision and accordingly a report was published on 14 December 2009.
	However, before this Delegated Decision could be made, a further Cabinet decision on 9 February 2010 withdrew the proposal to create the new Rural Primary School. This withdrawal meant that the federation partner proposed by Chale CE Primary School would no longer exist and therefore the Chale CE Primary School proposal became null and void.
	Chale CE Primary School was given the opportunity to seek a federation with the existing and now continuing schools of Chillerton & Rookley, Godshill and Wroxall primaries but no federation proposal was forthcoming.
	The delegated decision report on the null and void federation proposal has therefore now been withdrawn.
