Decision Taken

Option 3: To determine the amount of uplift to be applied to Older People and Physical Disability Residential and Nursing Home Care Providers for 2012/13.

• For residential homes

Uplift 2.92% plus 0.29% providers contingency support programme and 0.25% business efficiency savings contribution. Plus 0.039% Return on Capital Employed, making a total of **3.499% rounded up to 3.50%**

• For nursing homes

Uplift 2.66% plus 0.27% providers contingency support programme and 0.25% business efficiency savings contribution, plus 0.039% Return on Capital Employed, making a total of **3.219% rounded up to 3.22%**

Reasons for the Decision

Following consultation with providers, consideration of responses, the need to achieve a fair price for care that reflects local issues, the decision was considered to fairly reflect the cost of care.

Options Considered And rejected Option 1: to provide no % uplift for 2012/13

Option 2: to provide an uplift as provisionally offered, namely:

• For residential homes:

Uplift 2.92% plus 0.29% providers contingency support programme and 0.25% business efficiency savings contribution, making a total of **3.46%**

• For nursing homes:

Uplift 2.66% plus 0.27% providers contingency support programme and 0.25% business efficiency savings contribution, making a total of **3.18%**
