The Portfolio Holder gave consideration to the Premises Strategy Development 10 Year Plan and capital programme. Property Services had carried out an Asset Management Plan for each fire station in August 2002 and this had formed the basis to update the ten-year premises strategy. Issues facing each of the Islands fire stations were highlighted in the report including condition of the buildings, condition of facilities and maintenance backlogs.

The strategy had been devised to ensure that existing or planned work would allow stations to maintain their serviceability, asset value, safety as a place of work and operational efficiency and had been set against the balance of risk and cost to the authority.

The Portfolio Holder considered the Strategic Plan for the implementation, use and development of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in the Fire Service, which had

been produced in support of the Resource Plan that was presented to the Executive on 11 December 2001.

Although it was not possible for specific costs to be projected, those parts of the ICT Project which had been planned and costed, had had revenue bids submitted in the current budget round. These bids had taken into account initial purchase of identified systems, the required training, and ongoing support costs which would be kept under review.

DECISION TAKEN :
