As always I am here to represent YOU the electorate on issues you want resolved.

So far this year I have managed to achieve:

DOUBLE YELLOW LINES: Just outside of the Rec. Park Rd. This will allow anyone entering and exiting the site safer visibility.

THE REMOVAL of 2-3 parking spaces in Pelham Rd, BUT the creation of around 10-13 parking spaces in the restricted parking area!

THE ADDITION of up to 5 parking spaces in Arctic cycle road way; it was the intention to put double yellow down both sides of the road.

ST.FAITHS: Additional 3-4 parking spaces where double yellow was proposed.

NEWPORT RD: So many comments about this one.....Managed to gain an extra 3 spaces than was proposed.

DISABILITY FRIENDLY: With the help of Highways, have now secured COMPLETE DISABLED access along the High St. and parade AND secured extra disabled spaces on the parade.

NUMEROUS boundary disputes; although still in the process of these with the Crown Estate.

SCHOOL enquiries with regards to placing and transport issues. PLANNING: always contentious, but I am here to represent your views, which I always do.

TREES: Again, getting these pruned (at appropriate time of year) around this area, including having ivy removed from beautiful large old oak that is being choked.
