In the past year I have been pleased and to serve the residents of Godshill and Wroxall in a number of ways.

With regard to highways I have again reported many potholes. I arranged meetings for residents concerned with traffic speeds near Allendale Newport Road Godshill. I have also made many representations about the water coming out of the BT cover at Whiteley Bank. I also supported Godshill Parish Council and residents with their objections to the proposed pavement scheme opposite the shop in Godshill.

Planning. I have arranged meetings with planning officers for both Parish Council Chairmen and residents concerned with planning matters.

Housing. I have had meetings with housing officers and asked in Full Council about the weighting on the housing register for Island families.

Schools. I have had meetings with both headteachers and attended Nativity plays and attended Wroxall School open day. I also attended a tea party to welcome Mr Neil Bosworth the new headteacher at Godshill.
