As part of the organising committee for the Island Games I worked extremely hard to ensure that the Games were a success. Certainly we had excellent weather and the visiting Islands really enjoyed their stay. I was responsible for accommodating athletes and officials, nearly 4,000 visitors all told and I am pleased to report that the Games were successful financially. The Opening Ceremony, attended by Lord Coe, was truly inspirational and the thousands of people who lined the streets of Ryde enjoyed an amazing spectacle. The Duke of Kent visited the Isle of Wight Seam Railway to view the new carriage shed.
