ISLE OF WIGHT COUNCIL

DANGEROUS WILD ANIMALS

LICENCE CONDITIONS

- 1. The animal shall not be kept by anyone other than the person or persons specified in the licence.
- 2. The animal shall normally be held at the premises specified in the licence.
- 3. The animal shall not be moved from those premises (except as may be detailed in the licence).
- 4. The licensee(s) shall hold a current insurance policy which insures him/her against liability for any damage which may be caused by the animal. The terms of the policy shall be satisfactory.
- 5. The species and number of animals of each species shall be restricted to those specified in the attached Schedule.
- 6. The person to whom the Licence is granted shall at all reasonable times make available a copy of the Licence to any person entitled to keep any animal under the authority of the Licence.

7. IN THE EVENT OF AN ESCAPE OR LOSS OF THESE ANIMALS THE ISLE OF WIGHT COUNCIL MUST BE INFORMED IMMEDIATELY

- 8. Any other reasonable condition may be attached at the request of the veterinary inspector on behalf of the Council.
- 9. The Council may vary these conditions at any time.
