## LICENCE CONDITIONS FOR SITES FOR INDIVIDUAL RESIDENTIAL CARAVANS FOR THE FORMER BOROUGH OF SOUTH WIGHT

## In respect of Site situated at:

- 1. The caravan shall be sited in accordance with the plan approved with the licence application or with approved amendments where applicable.
- 2. (a) The caravan shall be of a proprietary or similar type and shall comply with BSS 3632:1970 or subsequent modifications thereof.
  - (b) Adequate means of permanent ventilation shall be provided to the caravan.
  - (c) Windows of sufficient area to give a satisfactory standard of natural lighting shall be provided to the caravan.
  - (d) The caravan shall be maintained in such condition as to be capable of mobility and transportation.
  - (e) The caravan shall be kept weatherproof, dry, clean and well maintained internally and in a good state of external repair.
- 3. The caravan shall not be used for sleeping accommodation by a greater number of persons than it can reasonably be regarded as having been designed to accommodate.
- 4. No apparatus of equipment shall be operated in such a manner as to cause annoyance to other persons by noise.
- 5. The site shall be maintained in a clean and tidy condition at all times and all equipment facilities and site buildings shall be maintained in good repair and proper order.
- 6. (a) The caravan shall stand on a hard-standing of suitable materials extending over the whole area occupied by the caravan and should project not less than one metre outwards from the entrance or entrances to the caravan.
  - (b) All grass on the site shall be kept short at all times.
- 7. (a) The site shall be provided with a water supply complying with British Standards Code or Practice CP 310 (1952).



- (b) The caravan standing should be provided with a piped water supply or a water standpipe with an adequate supply of water and should be situated not more than 18 metres from the caravan standing.
- 8. Satisfactory provision shall be made for foul drainage by:
  - (a) connection to a public sewer; or
  - (b) where a public sewer is not available, by discharge to a properly constructed septic tank or cesspool.
- 9. (a) Any water standpipe shall discharge over a trapped gully surrounded by an adequate concrete apron and connected to an approved waste water disposal system.
  - (b) All wastepipes from the caravan shall discharge to an approved waste water disposal system by either a trapped gully or approved direct connection.
- 10. (a) The caravan shall be provided with a water closet, wash basin with hot and cold water and bathing facilities connected to the foul drainage system; or
  - (b) Such other facilities as the Licensing Authority may approve.
- 11. (a) A suitable refuse container shall be provided and must be emptied as necessary to prevent overspill or nuisance.
  - (b) The disposal of refuse shall be to the satisfaction of the Licensing Authority.
- 12. (a) Gas cylinders shall not be stored in or under the caravan.
  - (b) Paraffin heaters shall not be kept or used in the caravan.
- 13. Suitable and sufficient provision shall be made for fire fighting to the satisfaction of the Licensing Authority.
