With reference to our telephone conversation I would like to make the following comments:

The crime and disorder issues based purely on the plans is very small once they are built and working and in this regard we have no objections.

However, the potential for crime and disorder is very high whilst they are being built based on the very strong objections and the possibility that some extremists may wish to stop, delay or disrupt them being built.

I would request that a condition is placed on any successful application, similar to the Isle of Wight Act, whereby the Chief Officer of Police is consulted at all stages for crime prevention advice and the contractors must follow the advice given to protect their property, their workers, their workers property, disruption to local traffic, disruption for local residents etc.

I do not wish to go into detail of any crime prevention methods as this would defeat the object by advising any potential law breakers of what we will advise.
