SAFEGUARDING – PROPOSED WIND FARM AT WELLOW

Thank you for the planning application dated 08 September 2006. I can confirm that the Ministry of Defence does not have any concerns providing that;

- the turbines do not exceed 6 in number; and
- the turbines do not exceed 109.5 metres to blade tip.

If the application is altered in any way, we must be consulted again as even the slightest change could unacceptably affect us. If planning permission is granted you must tell us;

- the date construction starts and ends;
- the maximum height of construction equipment;
- if the turbines will be lit; and
- the latitude and longitude of every turbine.

This information is vital and will be plotted on flying charts to make sure that military aircraft avoid this area.
